Coollest Competition Rules
Middle School and High School



Objective: The objective is to create a one of a kind basswood car.

Judging

Participants: 10 teams per school, with 2 members per team.

Submission: All submissions must be delivered to Sandhills Community College (by school personnel) on Wednesday, April 1, 2026, to Little Hall, Room 153. Cars must be marked with school name and student name(s) for identification.

Judging Location: Judging will take place prior to FunFest and cars will be on display at Funfair.

SCC Judge: Brian Garner, Department Chair, Transportation Services and Associate Professor, Automotive Technology and Coordinator, Collision Repair & Refinishing.

Notes: Cars submitted for coolest cars are for display only and not for racing in Metric 500 Fastest.

Determining the winner: The coolest car placement for both the Middle School and High School divisions will be determined by a visual inspection by the judges.

Competition Rules: Metric 500 Coolest Competition

1. Show cars (design only) must be made from basswood blank.
2. No drawing is required.
3. Cars for show do not require holes for a CO2 cartridge.
4. You **may** add accessories, embellishments, etc. to cars.
5. Show cars must have 4 wheels.
6. One piece construction is required (i.e. no glued attachments allowed), however axles can be attached via a straw which can be glued to the car

Judges will perform a visual inspection of cars to determine placement.
